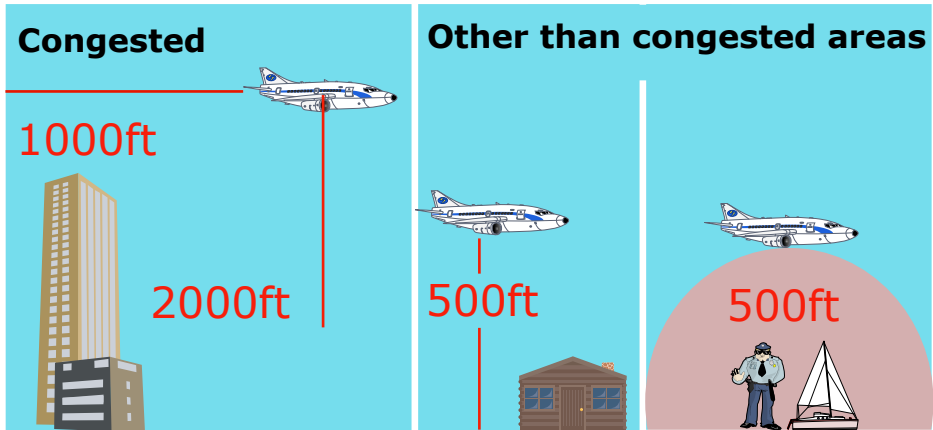


Chapter 4 - Regulations (1)

Min Safe Altitudes, AC categories,



Congested Areas

1000 ft over the highest obstacle within horizontal radius ->2000 ft

Other than congested

500 ft over surface, expect open water or sparsely populated areas, but not closer than 500 ft to any person, vessel, vehicle or structure

Anywhere

Altitude, which will allow an emergency landing without hazard to persons or property

Categories of AC

Grouping of AC based upon intended use or operation limitations:

Normal, utility, acrobatic, restricted, experimental, transport, limited, Both, restricted and experimental are prohibited from carrying pers. or property for compens. or hire. Both are normally prohibited from flying over densely populated areas and in congested airways.

Airworthiness

- Airworthiness Certificate (valid as long as maintained as required)
- Operating limitations (flight manual, markings, placards)
- Registration Certificate (issued to the owner)

ADs, ACs, NOTAMs

Airworthiness Directives (identify unsafe aircraft conditions and Prescribe actions and limitations.

Compliance with ADs must be entered in the AC maintenance records.
