Fitness for Flight

Hazardous Attitudes	Antidotes
Antiauthority (don't tell me)	Follow the Rules They are usually right
Impulsivity (do something quickly)	Not so fast Think first
Invulnerability (it won't happen to me)	It could happen to me
Macho (I can do it)	Taking chances is foolish Taking risks is foolish
Resignation (what's the use?)	I'm not helpless, can make a difference

Collision Avoidance

- Atmospheric Haze** (all features appear to be farther away)
- Night Flight** (avoid bright white lights 30 min before the flight)
- Scanning** (a series of short, regular spaced eye movements to search each 10 degree sector)

Aircraft Lighting



The Aircraft must display lighted Position lights from sunset to sunrise (Except Alaska)

Turn on Landing Lights when operating below 10,000ft (day or night), especially when operating within 10 miles of any Airport or in conditions with reduced visibility or in areas with flocks of birds.
